

How to Get Your ePub to Your Device

Thank you for your support, and for buying your eBook directly from me! Buying direct from the author typically benefits the author far more than buying through a retailer, so know that we appreciate your support!

Your ePub files can be read on iPhones/iPads/Mac (Apple Books), Kobo eReader, Nook eReader or Androids/PCs (Google Play).

This guide will walk you through how to send your newly acquired ePub to wherever you prefer to read!

Sending Your Book to the Kindle App

Make sure you have the Kindle App downloaded on your phone.

Open the email with your ePub attached.

For iPhone:

1. Click the link to the file and hold down on the file icon. A menu should open which says Open In.
2. Select Kindle from the menu options. You might have to scroll over to find it.
3. Input the title and author.
4. Select send to app.
5. The file should now be in your app.

Depending on your settings, the file may automatically open in the Apple Books app for you to read.

For Android:

1. Download or save the file to your Android device.
2. On your Android device, go to your home screen then open your 'File Manager' or 'File Explorer.'
3. It's called 'Files' on some Android phones. On a Samsung Galaxy phone, it is likely in a folder called 'Samsung.'
4. On your 'File Manager,' locate your file you downloaded.
5. Select, copy your file, and then paste it to your Kindle folder. The Kindle folder is usually nested under the parent file directory (ex. /storage/sdcard). You should see it in your 'File Manager' or 'Files' folder.
 - If you are not seeing the Kindle folder, it may be that your phone settings are switched off for downloading files to the Kindle app if you are using phone data and not wifi. You can either connect to wifi or change the setting on your phone.
6. After pasting your file to the Kindle folder, close your file manager and then open your Kindle app.

7. As you can notice, the file has been already added to your carousel. If you still don't see it, just go to your Kindle app's menu then press "Sync." If pressing "Sync" does not work, and you still do not see the file, restart your Android and check the kindle app again.

Sending Your Book to Kindle eReader

Currently, you are only able to send ePub files to your Kindle eReader via Amazon's *Send to Kindle* feature using your Kindle device's embedded email address.

Sending Your Book to Apple Books (iPhone, iPad, Mac)

To read an eBook on your iPhone, iPad or Mac, the easiest way is to add it to your Apple Books library. You can do this by downloading it from our website using your iPhone/iPad, or your Mac.

To add an ePub file to Apple Books using an iPhone/iPad:

1. First, download the ePub file from our website, or link in your email, following your purchase. Tap on the downloads icon in the top right corner, then tap on the ePub file (named 978xxxxxxxxxx).
2. You will be taken to the Apple Books app, where the eBook will be added to your library!
3. The book will now appear in your Apple Books library on all of your devices.

To add an ePub file to Apple Books using a Mac:

1. First, download the ePub file from our website, or link in your email, following your purchase. On your Mac, open Apple Books.
2. Now all you need to do is to drag and drop the ePub file from your Mac to the open Apple Books window.
3. The book is added to your library.
4. The book will now appear in your Apple Books library on all of your devices.

Sending Your Book to Kobo eReader

To send your ePub to your Kobo eReader, you will have to use your computer (either Mac or PC will work). As a note, the content will only appear on the device that you used to import the content. This means that even after you sync, you won't see the item on your other eReaders or apps.

1. Turn on the eReader.
2. Connect the micro USB cable to your eReader and to your computer.
3. On your eReader, tap CONNECT when you see the "computer detected" window pop up.
4. On your computer, look for a drive named "KOBOREREADER" in the window explorer.
5. Drag the ePub files from your computer into the "KOBOREREADER" drive.
6. After the transfer is completed, eject your eReader from the computer by right-clicking on the 'KOBOREREADER' drive on your computer's desktop and click **Eject**.
7. Go to your library on the eReader. Your book should now be there.

Sending Your Book to Nook eReader

To add files using your computer:

1. Turn on the eReader.
2. Using the included cable, connect your eReader to your computer.
3. On your computer, look for a drive named "NOOK" to appear in the window explorer.
4. Drag the ePub files from your computer into the "NOOK" drive.
5. After the transfer is completed, eject your eReader from the computer by right-clicking on the 'NOOK' drive on your computer's desktop and click **Eject**.
6. Go to your library on the eReader and navigate to the My Files section. Your book should now be there.

To add files directly from the Nook device:

1. Swipe up from the bottom of the Home screen and select Import, or swipe right to the More section in My Library and select Import. This will display a file menu you can navigate in order to find the file to import into your library.
2. Tap or click on the file to select it.
3. Tap or click on the Import button to add it to your NOOK Library.
4. You can view and open imported files from the My Files section of your NOOK Library.

Sending Your Book to Google Play (Android/PC)

To read an eBook on your Android device or your PC browser, the easiest way is to add it to your Google Play library. You can do this by downloading it from our website using your Android device, or your PC.

To add an ePub file to Google Play using an Android device:

1. First, download the ePub file from our website, or link in your email, following your purchase.
2. Go to the directory where your eBook file is saved on your Android device using any file manager and tap on the ePub file.
3. In the 'Complete action using' popup, select 'Upload to Play Books'. The ePub file will start uploading. It might take a minute with larger files. You can also upload the ePub file directly from an email.
4. The eBook is now added to your Google Play library and will appear in Google Play on all of your devices. In order to store your eBooks offline, simply tap on the Pin icon next to each book. After the eBook is downloaded on your device, you can read it without an internet connection.

To add an ePub file to Google Play using a PC:

1. First, download the ePub file from our website, or link in your email, following your purchase.
2. Open the Google Play Books website on your PC and ensure you are signed into your Google account.
3. Click on the 'My Books' button on the left, then click 'Upload files' on the top right. Either drag and drop the ePub file stored on your PC, or click on the 'Select files from your device' button to upload the ePub file. The upload process might take a while, depending on the size of the ePub file, and once the upload process is complete, a short Processing time will follow.
4. The eBook is now added to your Google Play library and will appear in Google Play on all of your devices
